Wheatstone Aura8IP Wins Radio World “Cool Stuff” Award

NEW BERN, NC, USA (April 14, 2011) — Wheatstone Corporation proudly announces that our Aura8IP Audio Processing BLADE is the recipient of the radio broadcast industry’s most prestigious technology honor, the Radio World "Cool Stuff" Award, given by a panel of expert engineering judges at the 2011 NAB Show in Las Vegas.

Part of the WheatNet-IP Intelligent Network, the Aura8IP occupies a single rack space, but packs an impressive complement of eight fully independent multiband stereo audio processors, making use of our exclusive Vorsis processing technology.

Each processing chain consists of a 4-band parametric equalizer followed by a crossover and three bands of compression. The compressors each feed their own limiters, whose outputs are then fed to a broadband lookahead limiter for tight peak control. The BLADE has its own local I/O, with eight stereo pairs of AES Digital audio in and out, and can function as a standalone processing engine or as part of a WheatNet-IP Intelligent Network.
